Old Business:

Road update by Trustee LaHaie. Brining the gravel roads in the township will begin soon after the grading has been done. There are cones on Wing Road and Indian Trail Road indicating that repairs will start soon.

Transfer Station update by Supervisor Gaynor. Rod Jones III has taken the position of attendant. Since opening on May 23rd it has been quite busy. There is no Spring Clean-Up scheduled at this point.

Trustee Elliott discussed the need to bring high-speed internet to our rural areas. Options and the possibilities of finding grants to fund this project were discussed.

The topic of blight in the Township was discussed with ordinance information provided by Attorney MacArthur.
